**NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT**

On August 1, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission issued an Order granting an application by Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia") seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience authorizing it to abandon natural gas service to Two Inactive Residential Premises located in Shippenville, Clarion County, Pennsylvania. As of April 2, 2026, the abandonment of these Premises has been completed. Accordingly, pursuant to Ordering Paragraph Three (3) of the Order issued August 1, 2024, Columbia hereby submits this verified Notice of Abandonment, with the following information:

**(a) The completion date for the abandonment of gas service to the two inactive residential premises:**

April 2, 2026

**(b) A statement explaining how compliance with 49 C.F.R. § 192.727 relating to abandonment or deactivation of facilities was completed:**

On April 2, 2026, Columbia physically disconnected the facilities that once served the premises, purged the facilities of the remaining gas, and capped the line to complete the abandonment in compliance with 49 C.F.R. § 192.727(d).


