Dear Attorneys Harrold and Bakare:

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) writes to inform you that, upon review of the supplemental materials provided, it has conditionally accepted for filing the above-captioned application, as amended (Application).

It will be necessary for Pennsylvania-American Water Company – Wastewater Division (PAWC-WD) to serve copies of the Application upon the following entities and then file proof of such service with the Commission, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.57 and 1.58:

1. Each city, borough, town, township, county, and related planning office, which is included, in whole or in part, in the proposed service area;
2. Each water or wastewater utility, municipal corporation or authority which provides water or wastewater collection, treatment, or disposal service to the public and whose service area abuts or is within 1 mile of the service area proposed in the Application; and
3. The Office of Consumer Advocate, Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP's) central and appropriate regional office.

PAWC-WD and Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC) are directed, upon receipt of this letter, to provide individualized notice of the proposed acquisition to all potentially affected PAWC and PAWC-WD customers, consistent with the Commission's Final Supplemental Implementation Order entered July 2, 2024, at Docket No. M-2016-2543193. PAWC-WD shall inform the Commission when it begins providing such individualized notice. PAWC-WD is also directed to ensure concurrent notice to all current East Coventry Township wastewater customers in similar fashion. Additionally, PAWC-WD shall publish the notice once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper having a general circulation in the area involved and file proof of publication with the Commission after publication has occurred.

Finally, PAWC-WD shall further amend its Application to provide the following information as required in the Commission's 66 Pa.C.S. §1329 Application Filing Checklist – Water/Wastewater 2024 Final Supplemental Implementation Order:

1. *Checklist Item No. 15.a. – Plant in Service. Provide an inventory of the used and useful plant assets to be transferred. Revise the Application's Amended Appendix A-15 to include an updated Engineering Assessment with an inventory of the used and useful plant assets to be transferred which incorporates the gravity sewer mains, laterals, and other appurtenances within the Coventry Chase Development that are used to provide wastewater service to customers billed by East Coventry Township for the same service as described in the Application.*
2. *Checklist Item No. 22.a. – Other requirements. Demonstrate compliance with the following: For wastewater system acquisitions, demonstrate compliance with the DEP-approved Act 537 Official Sewage Facilities Plans for the affected municipalities (including the extent of the requested service territory). Revise the Application's Appendix A-22-b to include a copy of the DEP-approved East Coventry Township Act 537 Official Sewage Facilities Plan Special Study for the proposed Parker Ford sewage facilities planning area (Parker Ford Area) along with a copy of the DEP approval letter of the same inclusive of any conditions; and*
3. *Checklist Item No. 22.a. – Other requirements. Demonstrate compliance with the following: For wastewater system acquisitions, demonstrate compliance with the DEP-approved Act 537 Official Sewage Facilities Plans for the affected municipalities (including the extent of the requested service territory). Revise the Application's Appendix A-22-b to include a copy of the DEP-approved East Coventry Township Act 537 Official Sewage Facilities Plan Special Study that addresses the Application's proposal of East Coventry Township providing wastewater conveyance and treatment bulk service to PAWC-WD via East Coventry Township's ownership of the one-foot section of sanitary sewer pipe as described in the Application along with a copy of the DEP approval letter of the same inclusive of any conditions.*

The filing of these supplemental materials shall be verified pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.36. Upon completion of the conditions established herein, PAWC-WD shall file a verification letter at this docket, indicating satisfaction of these conditions. The Commission will then issue

a Secretarial Letter finalizing acceptance of the filing. After final acceptance of the filing, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.14, the Commission will proceed with publishing notice of the Application in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. This matter will receive the attention of the Commission and you will be advised of any further necessary procedure.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration from the actions of staff with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served.
