Dear Parties:

On March 30, 2026, both PECO Energy Company – Electric Division and PECO Energy Company – Gas Division filed tariffs proposing to increase rates. This matter is currently pending before the Commission.

On April 8, 2026, the Commission received a letter from the Southeast Delegation of the Pennsylvania House Democratic Caucus. The Delegation’s letter was addressed to Commission Chairman, Stephen DeFrank. The Delegation’s letter contains statements and additional averments regarding the issues pending in the above-referenced cases.

Because the subject matter of the Delegation’s letter concerns the merits of a contested matter still pending before the Commission for final consideration, the Delegation’s letter constitutes an *ex parte* communication prohibited by Section 334(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 334(c). Accordingly, please be advised that, in order to cure the *ex parte* communication, I am placing the Delegation’s letter on the docket and serving a copy of this Secretarial Letter and the Delegation’s letter on all the Parties of Record to this case.
