On January 14, 2026, the Commission entered an Initial Decision in the above-referenced matter. Numerous parties have filed exceptions and reply exceptions to the Initial Decision. Because exceptions and reply exceptions have been filed, this matter is still currently pending before the Commission.

On April 7, 2026, the Commission received a letter from State Senator Tracy Pennycuick. Senator Pennycuick's letter was addressed to Commission Chairman, Stephen DeFrank, and carbon copied to the remaining Commissioners and the undersigned as the Secretary of the Commission.
