This initiative is driven by a transmission reliability need to enhance the overall transmission network; it is not classified as a FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company project. Accordingly, no FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company equipment will be impacted, except for interfaces where distribution facilities are interconnected with the transmission system and require reconnection.
