PETITION TO INTERVENE

NOW COMES, the Commission on Economic Opportunity (CEO), by and through counsel, Joseph L. Vullo, Esquire, and petitions to intervene in the above-captioned matter averring as follows:

1. The Petitioner, Commission on Economic Opportunity, is a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with its principal office located at 165 Amber Lane, P.O. Box 1127, Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, 18703-1127. CEO's telephone number is (570) 826-0510.

2. CEO is an advocate for its clients - the low-income population of Luzerne County - and has been directly involved in assuring that low-income persons' utility costs are contained through counseling, advice, payment assistance and energy conservation measures.

3. CEO seeks permission to intervene in UGI Electric Division's request for a rate increase filed with the Commission.

4. UGI Electric Division serves customers in numerous counties including Luzerne County.

5. CEO seeks permission to intervene in UGI Electric Division's request for a rate increase not only to address the proposed increase but to ensure the adequacy of the Company's programs for its low-income customers and the effect of any proposed increase on those programs

and customers. CEO will also address the administration and implementation of the Company's universal service programs

6. CEO's participation as an active party in this proceeding is required to protect its substantial interests and the substantial interests of the low-income citizens it represents in ensuring that utility rates remain affordable for its clients and to ensure that its low-income programs remain adequately funded and available. Accordingly, CEO's participation in this proceeding will serve the public interest.

7. Because CEO represents low-income citizens in Luzerne County, the interests of its clients are not being protected by any other party to this action.

8. CEO intervened and was an active party in the rate request filed by this Company in pursuant to docket no. R-2022-3037368.

POSITIONS

9. CEO reserves the right to set forth its position on the proposed rate increase. CEO's main purpose is to address the adequacy and availability of the Company's low-income programs and the affect of any proposed rate increase on those programs.

10. There is a substantial public interest in keeping utility costs affordable for all members of the community and any increase in rates should be accompanied by an increase in funding available to the Company's low-income programs so that its rates remain just and reasonable across all customer classes.

11. CEO expects to address the any proposed change in rate structure that would impact upon the motive and ability of low-income customers to reduce their monthly bills through conservation.


REQUEST FOR RELIEF


