**Re: Affiliated Service Agreement between Duquesne Light Company and Its Affiliate
Docket No. G-2025-3057802**

Dear Secretary Homsher:

In response to further inquiries from the Commission regarding the program, Duquesne Light will not serve as the billing agent under the agreement. When the project is financed, the financier will invoice the customer and get paid directly. If any portion of the project is funded by the customer, TEN will invoice Duquesne Light for progress payments during construction. According to the agreement, Duquesne Light will invoice the customer and include its administration fee.

Furthermore, the definition of eligible scope comes from the MSA definitions 1.7 and 1.8, which is taken from the GSA Areawide Contract definition. An Energy Conservation Measure (ECM) is also defined in 42 U.S. Code § 8259. An ECM is any specific energy or water related project or service intended to provide energy savings and/or demand reduction. An “Energy Management Service” or “EMS” means any project or service, including any ECM, that is intended to reduce and/or manage energy demand or water use in a facility as well as services that determine whether such reductions are feasible such as energy audits and any ancillary services necessary to ensure the proper operation of the energy or water conservation measure.

In addition, for financed projects, all payment risk transfers to the financier after project acceptance. The financing agreement requests that Duquesne Light assist with payment as needed, but does not obligate DLC to pay the financier. If the customer directly funds the project, that customer will make progress payments during construction.


