Request for Information

Questions for evaluation on a PUC Application require regulation compliant answers, they should be well thought out and complete, and must answer all parts of the questions asked. Please review Title 52 PA Code to ensure your answers meet that standard.

PLEASE PROVIDE CONCISE ANSWERS TO THE QUESTIONS, DO NOT PROVIDE NUMEROUS PAGES THAT DO NOT SPECIFICALLY ADDRESS AND ANSWER THE QUESTIONS ASKED.

- 1) There is currently an outstanding Assessment payment for 2025 that must be made before certification will be given for this application. If you have questions, call that department at 717-265-7548. The new authority will not be granted without that payment being made.
- 2) Your company has a long history of failure to report earnings and remain in compliance with PUC regulations you agreed to for original Certification. That has resulted in a significant number of fines that had to be prosecuted and paid. Please state what plan has been put in place so that you will report and pay assessments promptly in the future, and will adhere to PUC regulations.
- 3) In regard to Question #10 of the application for proposed service area: You must provide an acceptable territory, written as we would publish it, from the examples provided. You must present the territory as you intend for it to be.

Please consider that your request should only indicate the areas from which you intend to **originate** service. Your proposed service area must also be fully bound, and easily discernible. This may be achieved by the use of municipal boundaries, roads, railroads, or natural boundaries such as rivers and streams, etc. Generally speaking, naming counties is the most wide-spread manner of achieving this goal, but other properly bound descriptions are acceptable if correctly prepared. Examples of sample territories are provided on the application itself, and your proposed territory should be written in similar format, clearly and concisely.

YOU SHOULD ONLY SPECIFY AREAS FROM WHICH YOU WISH TO ORIGINATE SERVICE.

Example(s):

- a. To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in Paratransit service, between points in the counties of X, Y, and Z.
