
I am writing to you to request that you carefully and seriously consider the impact of Pennsylvania American Water's acquisition of the Indian Creek Valley Water Authority as it pertains to existing customer/rate payers. While I do not object to their acquisition, I am concerned that the acquisition may result in possible upgrades or improvements to Indian Creeks systems which, I believe, may result in an unfair cost to existing rate payers. If any upgrades may be required, the former Indian Creek customers should exclusively bear those costs or Pennsylvania American and its stockholders should bear the costs, since the Company's value is increased by the acquisition.

In our March billing statement, Pennsylvania American included an insert which stated, in part, "...At this time, based on a preliminary analysis of the potential rate impacts, PAWC estimates that the rates of the average customer could increase." I contend that it is patently unfair to charge existing customers merely because PAWC chose to acquire another water company. How did this acquisition add to the service I have already been receiving? This may add to the value of the company but not to the quantity, availability or quality of the water I receive.

In conclusion, I am requesting that the Commission deny ANY request by Pennsylvania American Water Company for a rate increase, based solely on this acquisition, to existing customers.
