RE: Comments of Combined Public Communications, LLC Challenging the Tentative Order
Canceling Certificates of Public Convenience Docket No. M-2026-3059781 Utility Code: 3117817

Dear Secretary Homsher:

On behalf of Combined Public Communications, LLC ("the Company"), please accept these formal comments submitted in response to the Commission's Tentative Order adopted on March 12, 2026, regarding the cancellation of Certificates of Public Convenience (CPC) for telecommunication utilities reporting zero intrastate operating revenue for calendar year 2024.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of the Tentative Order, Combined Public Communications, LLC hereby formally challenges the rebuttable presumption that it is not operating or providing jurisdictional telecommunications services in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

While the Company acknowledges that it reported \$0 in gross intrastate operating revenue for the 2024 calendar year, this temporary lack of intrastate revenue did not constitute an abandonment of service. Throughout 2024, the Company maintained its CPC, its operational readiness, and its ability to serve Pennsylvania consumers without unreasonable interruptions of service, in full compliance with 66 Pa.C.S. § 1501.

Most importantly, to rebut the presumption of non-operation, Combined Public Communications, LLC confirms that it is actively providing jurisdictional telecommunications services in the Commonwealth in the current calendar year. For the 2025 reporting period to date, the Company has generated active intrastate operating revenue (currently totaling \$379.00).

Because Combined Public Communications, LLC is actively operating and currently generating jurisdictional intrastate revenue in 2025, canceling its CPC at this juncture would be contrary to the public interest. Revocation of the CPC would needlessly disrupt active service to current Pennsylvania consumers and impose an unnecessary administrative burden on an actively operating telecommunications provider.

Based on the foregoing, Combined Public Communications, LLC respectfully requests that the Commission accept these comments as successfully challenging the rebuttable presumption of non-operation. The Company requests that it be removed from Appendices A and B, and that the Commission exclude Combined Public Communications, LLC from the Final Order canceling Certificates of Public Convenience.

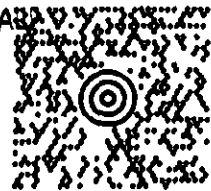

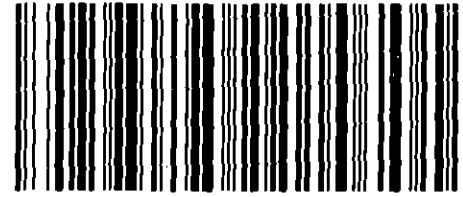
