Carriers seeking to operate in interstate commerce must complete form [MCS-150 "Combined Motor Carrier Identification Report."](#) To apply for Interstate Operating Authority, a carrier must complete the appropriate form in the [OP-1 series](#). THE NEW ENTRANT SAFETY AUDIT

Within your first 12 months, you will be notified by a DOT officer to schedule your New Entrant Safety Audit. You can review additional information regarding Department of Transportation regulations or Safety Audits directly from the [FMCSA's website here](#).

To help you prepare, here is a short list of some items you will be required to show a DOT officer during your audit:

Vehicle Inspection Requirements:

- 5lb Fire Extinguisher (Mounted)
- First Aid Kit
- Additional (Extra) Fuses
- Reflective Triangles (3)
- MC# and DOT# at least 2" in height on each side of your truck in contrasting colors
- Business name clearly shown on both sides of vehicle
- Current DOT Vehicle Inspection Report (within 12 months)

Compliance Document Requirements:

- Proof of Insurance
- BOC-3 (Interstate)
- UCR (Interstate)
- 30 days of RODS (Records of Duty / HOS info from your ELD)
- Driver Qualification File

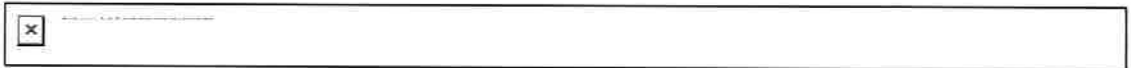
- Proof of compliance with Drug and Alcohol regulations (if applicable)
