Request for Information

1.) Question # 2 Verified Statement of Applicant.

Is there a sharing of assets and/or facilities between North Carolina, Georgia and Pennsylvania (PA)? If so, is there financial compensation from PA to those companies?

2.) Question # 3 of the Verified Statement.

A.) Please provide verifiable documentation of the previous experience mentioned.

B.) Who will be the Pennsylvania Managing the staff and what is their individual experience?

- Household goods applicants are required to establish that they have the technical ability to provide the proposed service safely and legally.

3.) Question # 4 of the Verified Statement.

A.) Please respond with a clear description of where your vehicle will be parked in relation to the physical address.

B.) What are the plans for storing a shipper's goods, if the move cannot be completed in one day?

4.) Question # 5 of the Verified Statement.

Please review the requirements of the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and provide a required plan for drivers that fully demonstrates compliance with the below cited statutes.

A.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.11 - Age restrictions (minimum age).

B.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.25 – Review of driver record. (schedule).

C.) 52 Pa Code § 31.134 - Criminal history. (frequency of record check, disqualification of employment, and record retention).

D.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR part 391.27 relating to training program.

What are the criteria for successful completion of training? How long is probationary period? Attach the structured training program mentioned, with these answers.

E.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 382 relating to controlled substances and alcohol use testing. Please give the names of companies you are considering for conducting drug/alcohol preemployment, post-accident, and random tests. What are the consequences for your driver(s) if they do not comply?

5.) The Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet).

A.) Revise the balance sheet by removing personal assets and debts.

- The information provided is to be strictly limited to assets and debts held by the applicant (Simple Relocations LLC), and not the individual member(s). Any property listed must be registered or titled to the company– personal property should not be included.

B.) You must provide proof of ownership/registration in the name of Simple

Relocations LLC for claimed vehicles, 401k and land/buildings or remove from them from the Balance Sheet.

- We need to know if the applicant is co-mingling member's assets/debts, which is not permissible.

- C.) At this point it is expected that the applicant's account is now filled and ready to commence operations with the ability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. Please provide supporting documentation for the balance sheet.
- Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of "Simple Relocations LLC". (account numbers may be redacted)
- Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the revised balance sheet.
 - It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service.

Note: As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged.
