On February 19, 2026, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) accepted Engie Power & Gas LLC's application to withdraw its Electric Generation Supplier license. In order for us to complete our analysis of your application, the Energy Industry Group requires answers to the attached questions.

Please use the Commission's efilings system or an overnight delivery service to submit the requested information to the Secretary of the Commission **within 30 days** from the date of this letter.
