Request for Information

- 1.) You have applied for Contract Carrier of Passengers Authority. That authority is specifically designed for companies that contract with specific entities that must be named in said authority and included on the Permit. Signed contracts must be submitted prior to that authority being granted. Additionally, Contract Carrier of Passenger Authority does not allow for adding or removing contractors without a new application, fee, and protest period. Contract carrier of passengers does not appear to be the appropriate authority for your company.
- 2.) Transportation services for schools are largely outside the jurisdiction of the Public Utility Commission, and such services have also been named in your application. Group services for charters require a different vehicle size than you have listed, that being 11 – 15 passengers, including the driver. You have also mentioned prearranged trips as well as on demand, but on demand is limited strictly to taxi services.
- 3.) Your application does not appear to describe any work you would be doing that is under the jurisdiction of the Public Utility Commission. Please provide additional and specific information that would clarify.
- 4.) Include all of the following: Who will be transported? Who will make the payment for your services? Will services be paid per person or as a group? Please fully explain your intended operations, the information provided in your application was insufficient to provide a clear overview of your intended operations.
