The parties in this proceeding respectfully request an adjournment of the Prehearing Conference, currently scheduled for April 22, 2026. PECO and Norfolk Southern are continuing to work to identify and mitigate the issues at the subject railroad crossings. Norfolk Southern provided PECO with its expert reports on March 26, 2026. An adjournment until mid- to late-June will permit PECO additional time to review Norfolk Southern's reports and for the parties to confer regarding potential mitigation options.

We are not aware of any false activations occurring at the railroad crossings since Norfolk Southern provided an update to Your Honors on February 24, 2026.
