In accordance with Ordering Paragraphs 2-3 of the Commission's Order dated November 6, 2025, enclosed please find the Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC") PFAS Litigation Universal Credit Rider Report ("Report").

As reflected in the enclosed Report, PAWC applied a second PFAS Litigation Universal Credit to eligible water customers based on additional PFAS litigation settlement proceeds, including interest. Following the application of this credit, \$186 remained undistributed for customer credits. Consistent with the Commission's Order, this excess amount will be contributed to PAWC's H2O Help to Others Program to fund customer Hardship Grants.


