

Request for Information

1.) Question #10 of the application.

A.) This addition territory application cannot include territory already authorized. You have included both Allegheny and Beaver Counties. Please provide an updated page 3 of the application with the corrected territory which must exclude the territory you are currently authorized to work in. File it as an amendment to this application A-2026-3061764.

B.) Please revise your territory request to fit the Commission's certain language and template. The territory needs to be clear and concise. Refer to the attached list of territory/service templates on the last page of this data request for helpful examples.

2.) Question #4 of the verified Statement.

A.) Please include your policy on how you plan to secure sensitive physical documents.

B.) Respond with a clear description of where your vehicle will be parked in relation to the physical address.

3.) Question #5 of the applicant's verified statements.

You need to provide a compliant schedule of the checks. Please reference requirements of Title 52 of the Pennsylvania § 29.504. Driver's license checks. and Code § 29.505.

Criminal history., which may be accessed at www.pacode.com.

4.) Financial Position (Balance Sheet).

- A.) Please provide supporting documentation for the balance sheet. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of **LeasingWorldEnterprises LLC** (account numbers may be redacted).
- B.) Provide copies of registrations of the vehicles claimed in the name of **LeasingWorldEnterprises LLC**.
- C.) ALL relevant assets and debts are to be included, not the number of vehicles owned.
Example of assets and debts: asset value / loan balances. Provide this information on a revised Balance Sheet
- Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the balance sheet.

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged.

PASSENGER CARRIER TERRITORY EXAMPLES AND EXPLANATIONS:

The Public Utility Commission is specifically concerned with the location in which trips by your company will ORIGINATE. Your requested territory must have boundaries and are typically requested by County / Counties.

Take care in choosing the correct language. You must file a new application and pay an additional fee to amend any approved territory.

Examples below:

1) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This territory means that you are not limited to a vehicle type, not limited to the type of activity regarding non-emergency medical transportation, or transportation for virtually any reason. This language would give your company the broadest customer base to work from.

2) To transport persons, by motor vehicles, in Paratransit service, in wheelchair vans, between points in (County name/names here).

This territory means that you must:

a) provide all services in wheelchair vans, and

b) could travel only between points within the county or counties requested as your territory. You could not leave those counties and return.

3) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, limited to persons whose personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This language is strictly for companies that specialize in transporting Amish people, this is NOT to be used for persons who are elderly and cannot drive, or who do not have a vehicle for any other reason.
