Dear Secretary Homsher,

ResCom Energy LLC d/b/a NextVolt Energy ("ResCom Energy") submits this letter as its Notification of Material Change in compliance with applicable rules that may require a notification of information associated with its competitive retail energy supplier license.

On February 9, 2026, PJM Interconnection ("PJM") notified ResCom Energy that it was in breach of its weekly bill payment (MTD 1/28/2026) and gave ResCom Energy until February 12, 2026, to satisfy the outstanding payment. On February 10, 2026, PJM issued a collateral call and gave ResCom Energy until February 12, 2026, to satisfy the call. In addition, PJM issued its weekly invoice (through February 4, 2026, which included the balance of January 2026), and required payment by February 13, 2026.

On February 12, 2026, the funds which were due to satisfy the initial MTD 1/28/2026 bill payment remained unpaid. PJM issued a Default Notice and notified the utilities of ResCom Energy's default and that customers would be returned to the electric utility's supply service.

On February 13, 2026, PJM sent a formal Notice to ResCom Energy advising them that they were in breach of its obligations for the monthly January invoice and the February 4, 2026 MTD weekly invoice. PJM further advised ResCom Energy that it would have until February 18, 2026, to cure the breach to avoid further default under the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement of PJM Interconnection.

On February 18, 2026, ResCom Energy satisfied both the payment and collateral defaults, and PJM notified ResCom Energy that the defaults and breaches had been cured. Currently, PJM has not authorized ResCom Energy to resume service load.

ResCom Energy is continuing its discussions with PJM to remain active throughout the PJM footprint where it is licensed to serve. ResCom Energy will update the Commission by April 20, 2026 of its status for serving in the PJM territory.

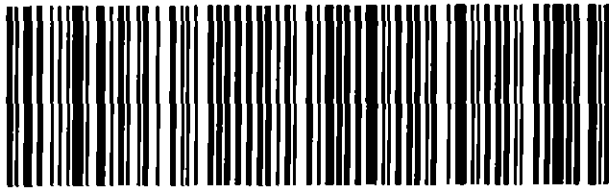
