**PARTIES OF RECORD**

City of Philadelphia vs. CSX Transportation. Inc.

To Whom It May Concern:

On July 11, 2022, the City of Philadelphia (City) filed a Formal Complaint against CSX Transportation Inc. alleging various issues along the 25<sup>th</sup> Street Viaduct from Washington Avenue to Oregon Avenue.

On August 1, 2022, CSX Transportation. Inc., through its counsel, filed an Answer to the Complaint with New Matter.

On August 16, 2022, the City of Philadelphia through its counsel filed an Answer to the New Matter of CSX Transportation. Inc.

As of this date, there have been no further filings or prosecution of the existing above-mentioned case by either party.

On February 24, 2023, CSX Transportation. Inc., through its counsel, filed an application docketed at A-2023-3038516 to alter seven public highway/rail crossings where the 25<sup>th</sup> Street Viaduct crosses above seven public city streets in the City of Philadelphia.

On April 19, 2023, this Commission approved the application of CSX Transportation. Inc., to make various construction improvements to the 25<sup>th</sup> Street Viaduct.

On August 15, 2025, a Commission staff engineer conducted a final inspection of the work completed under the docketed proceeding A-2023-3038516 with the interested parties in which all work was deemed to be completed satisfactorily and in accordance with the Commission's Secretarial Letter.

On October 31, 2025, the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter closing the proceeding A-2023-3038516 as all physical work was completed satisfactorily and the parties did not petition the Commission for any outstanding matters including the final allocation of costs, allocations of maintenance or objections to closing the case.


As previously stated, there have been no further filings or prosecution of the existing docketed case C-2022-3033708 by either party and construction improvements have been made to the 25<sup>th</sup> Street Viaduct satisfactorily and as agreed upon by all parties under the application proceeding A-2023-3038516.

It is hereby formally requested that the City of Philadelphia, within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter submit on the record under this proceeding a certificate of satisfaction, a request to withdraw the complaint, or a request to prosecute the case through the Commission's Office of Administrative Law Judge.

If no filing on the record occurs within the stated twenty (20) days, the Commission will dismiss and close the case and deem all matters satisfied under this proceeding.
