RE: ELECTRIC LOAD FORECAST ACCOUNTABILITY

TO ALL ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION UTILITIES:

On April 17, 2026, PJM Interconnection LLC (PJM) issued a Request for Information (RFI) with responses due May 6, 2026, as part of its planned Reliability Backstop Procurement (RBP).¹ The RFI seeks information on terms, conditions and criteria in which parties would: (1) enter bilateral contracts and/or (2) participate in a PJM central procurement. PJM's proposed RBP process would set the initial procurement target using the 2026 Load Forecast for the estimated 2029 summer large load forecasts minus the 2026 summer large load forecasts. PJM will aggregate final Electric Distribution Company (EDC) targets to set a final Regional Transmission Organization (RTO) procurement target.

Act 45 of 2025 amended the state's Fiscal Code Act of April 9, 1929 (P.L. 343, No. 176), and, *inter alia*, requires the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) to investigate and validate load forecasts submitted by Pennsylvania utility companies to PJM.

Pursuant to Section 504 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 504, the Commission may require any public utility to file with it special reports concerning any matter whatsoever about which the commission is authorized to inquire, or to keep itself informed, or which it is required to enforce. To assist the Commission in conducting its review of the accuracy and transparency of load-forecast inputs, please respond with the information requested in Attachment 1, to be filed to Docket No. M-2025-3058814.

Please provide your response to the Secretary of the Commission at the address listed below by **May 18, 2026**. All documents requiring notary stamps must have original signatures. The Commission strongly encourages submission through eFiling with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an eFiling account through the Commission website and accepting eservice at <https://efiling.puc.pa.gov>. The Commission is accepting all public documents through our eFiling system at this time.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to either file by overnight delivery or submit it to the Secretary's Share Point File system to ensure the timely filing of your submission. Please note that pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.32(b)(4), a redacted, public version of confidential filings shall also be filed. 
