**ORDER REFERRING APPLICATION
TO TECHNICAL UTILITY SERVICES**

On January 5, 2026, Fampro Care Transport LLC (Applicant) filed an Application for Motor Common Carrier of Persons in Paratransit Service for Approval to “transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in paratransit service, from points in the counties of Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, and the City and County of Philadelphia to points in Pennsylvania.”

Notice of the Application was provided in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, 56 Pa.B. 1252 (February 28, 2026). Protests were due by March 16, 2026.

On March 16, 2026, Bucks County Transport, Inc. (BCT), Bux-Mont Transportation, Inc. (Bux-Mont), Easton Coach Company (Easton), Suburban Transit Network, Inc. (TransNet), and Tri County Transit Service, Inc. (Tri County)(collectively, “Joint Protestants”) filed a timely Joint Protest to the Application.

By Initial In-Person Hearing Notice dated March 18, 2026, an Initial In-Person Hearing in this matter was scheduled for May 13, 2026, and the matter was assigned to me.

On March 24, 2026, the Applicant and the Joint Protestants filed a Restrictive Amendment and Stipulation in which the Joint Protestants agreed to withdraw their Protest to the Application based upon the Restrictive Amendment and its acceptance by the Commission. The Application was amended to clearly identify and specify the territory requested so that the authority sought shall read as follows:

For the right to begin to transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in paratransit service, between points in the counties of Chester, Delaware, and the City and County of Philadelphia; and from points in the counties of Chester, Delaware, and the City and County of Philadelphia to points in the counties of Bucks and Montgomery and return.

As the Application is now unopposed, it will be referred to the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services for final review and resolution pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 3.381(c).

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

That the Application of Fampro Care Transport LLC, at Docket No. A-2026-3060038 be referred to the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services for review and resolution pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 3.381(c).
