Request for Information

- 1) The above stated application designates your company as a Contract Carrier of Passengers. Your answer to question 10 is as follows, “To transport passengers in motor vehicles as a contract carrier for contracted organizations, including healthcare and assisted living facilities, from points in Montgomery County and surrounding Counties to points within Pennsylvania, and return.” The National Provider Identifier lists True Companions LLC as a home health agency. Please explain all functions of your company in detail. Who do you intend to transport? Who pays for said transportation?
- 2) You must specifically name any and all organizations and PUC licensed Brokers that you intend to work with when establishing your authority / territory. While contracts can be added or removed in the future, the addition of any Broker or entity not named in this application will require another separate Contract Carrier of Passengers application and fee at a later date. Additionally, ALL Counties from which your trips originate must be specifically named in your authority, there can be no question as to the boundaries of your territory, which is a requirement of PUC Authority.
- 3) “While formal contracts have not yet been executed at this stage, the applicant is actively preparing to establish these agreements upon approval of operating authority. The company has identified its target partners and is positioned to enter into service contracts once authorized to operate.” This statement puts the cart before the horse. The PUC does not authorize Contract Carriers to operate without clearly identifying and stating the contractors which are required to be written into the authority itself. Please provide

documentation of intent provided by the contractors, or signed and dated contracts. You must list all brokers and entities with which you intend to do business. Please call to discuss, if you have questions, Jerome Elliott, 717-214-7155 (leave a message for a call back.)

- 4) The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. **Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements for frequency and retention of driver records.** Each of your answers to sections of this question were insufficient:

- § 29.503. Age restrictions.
- § 29.504. Driver history
- § 29.505. Criminal history.
