Response Questions

1) **Age Restrictions**

-Rules: All drivers must be at least 21 years old

Exception: Drivers 18-20 years old are permitted only if they are certified as emergency medical service driver, If you are using specialized medical transport vehicles, drivers may need to be registered as an **Emergency Medical Services Vehicle Operator (EMSVO)** even for non-emergency trips

Retention: These records must be maintained for 3 years.

Frequency: A new criminal history record must be reviewed on a month-to-month basis

2) Yes, I did a few insurance quotes, and there were some in the ranges of 400-500 dollars. The policies may change on a 6 to 12 month plan, depending on the growth of business.

3) It has taken me a while to access any additional funds to get to this point. I have an "X" account of a refund income tax credit of \$10,000 plus dollars. This is enough to hold me over for 6 months or more to obtain my day to day services/expenses. I did reach out to a couple commercial insurance adjusters that had the ranges of 400 to 500 dollars a month. With my experience and leads to build more services that are needed in my area. By obtaining a Paratransit service Certification from the PA PUC, allows me to run door to door services, non emergency medical transportation (NEMT) for passengers, also with the certification of wheelchair and stretcher will help as well. - 1) The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements, in particular regarding the frequency and retention of driver records. Each of your answers to sections of this question were insufficient:

- § 29.503. Age restrictions.
- § 29.504. Driver history
- § 29.505. Criminal history.

Even if you intend to be the only driver, you must have a code specified plan in place. Please find the required answers in Title 52, you can google to find them.

- 2) Your answer to question 8 on the Verified Statements, regarding whether or not you have taken steps to research the cost for Paratransit insurance was insufficient. Have you obtained quotes so that you are aware of the cost of said insurance for the services you intend to provide?
- 3) Your Statement of Financial Position shows funds that are insufficient to run a transportation business, with loans outstanding to be paid. Do you have additional access to funds for day to day expenses, insurance premiums, and necessary repairs if need to be able to provide safe, reliable and efficient services? It has been noted that your vehicle is 10 years old with 250,000 miles traveled.

Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:


