Your payment is an admission that you committed the alleged violations and an agreement to cease and desist from continuing further violations. Upon receipt of your payment, the Complaint proceeding shall be closed.

D. If you file an Answer which either admits or fails to deny the allegations of the Complaint, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement will request the Commission to issue an Order imposing the requested relief set forth in the Complaint.

E. If you file an Answer which contests the Complaint, the matter will be assigned to an Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. The Judge is not bound by the penalty set forth in the Complaint and may impose additional and/or alternative penalties as appropriate.

F. If you are a corporation, you must be represented by legal counsel. 52 Pa. Code § 1.21.

FORMAL COMPLAINT

NOW COMES the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”), by its prosecuting attorney, pursuant to Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 701, and files this Formal Complaint (“Complaint”) against Hassana L. Sessoms t/a A-1 Allentown Taxi LLC (“Respondent”) alleging violations of the Public Utility Code. In support of its Formal Complaint, I&E alleges the following:

I. PARTIES AND JURISDICTION

1. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”), with a mailing address of 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth and other entities acting within the scope of the Commission’s jurisdiction pursuant to the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 101, *et seq.*

2. The Commission regulates the intrastate transportation of passengers for compensation, including passenger transportation service provided by common carriers by motor vehicle and transportation brokers. 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 102, 2501.

3. Complainant is the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and is the entity established by statute to prosecute complaints against public utilities, pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 308.2(a)(11).

5. Respondent is Hassana L. Sessoms t/a A-1 Allentown Taxi LLC, with an address of 426 West Turner Street, Allentown, PA 18102.

6. Respondent does not hold a Certificate of Public Convenience or a brokerage license issued by this Commission.

7. Section 501(a) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 501(a), authorizes and obligates the Commission to execute and enforce the provisions of the Public Utility Code.

8. Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 701, authorizes the Commission to, *inter alia*, hear and determine complaints against persons and corporations for a violation of any law or regulation that the Commission has jurisdiction to administer.

9. Section 3301 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 3301, authorizes the Commission to impose civil penalties on any public utility, or any other person or corporation subject to the Commission's authority, for violation(s) of the Public Utility Code and/or Commission regulations.

10. Pursuant to the provisions of the applicable Commonwealth statutes and regulations, the Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Complaint and the actions of Respondent related thereto.

II. BACKGROUND

11. A-1 Allentown Taxi LLC provides unauthorized call or demand service and/or procures passenger transportation service with motor carriers. It is operated by Hassana L. Sessoms.

12. Respondent is a registered domestic limited liability company in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since November 24, 2020.

13. Respondent has been the subject of prior I&E investigations and prosecutions before the Commission, Magisterial District Courts, and the Court of Common Pleas of Lehigh County and has previously applied for authority without success.

14. On September 25, 2023, Respondent entered a guilty plea for violating 66 Pa.C.S. § 3310 for offering passenger transportation for compensation without Commission authority on September 6, 2023.¹ *See* I&E Exhibit 1.

15. The September 6, 2023 incident was also prosecuted before the Commission. By Secretarial Letter dated January 2, 2024, the Commission found Respondent in violation of 66 Pa.C.S. § 1101 for holding itself out to provide transportation of persons in call or demand service between points in Pennsylvania for compensation on September 6, 2023, while not having operating authority with the Commission.² The Commission imposed a civil penalty of

\$1,000 upon Respondent.³ On or about January 28, 2026, the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General transferred Respondent’s \$1,000 civil penalty payment to the Commission.

16. On or about September 26, 2023, Respondent filed an Application for Motor Common Carrier of Persons in Scheduled Route Service (“Application”) under the trade name “A-1 Allentown Taxi.”⁴ By Secretarial Letter dated November 28, 2023, Respondent’s Application was denied for failing to respond to data requests. Respondent did not file a Petition for Reconsideration of the determination set forth in the November 28, 2023 Secretarial Letter and the matter became final.

17. On February 6, 2025, Respondent entered a guilty plea for violating 66 Pa.C.S. § 3310 for offering passenger transportation for compensation without Commission authority on October 29, 2024.⁵ See I&E Exhibit 2.

III. INSTANT INCIDENTS OF UNAUTHORIZED TRANSPORTATION

A. March 21, 2025

18. On or about February 26, 2025, I&E Motor Carrier Enforcement Manager Anthony Bianco began an investigation related to an informal complaint regarding Respondent distributing business cards at the Fairfield Inn, 208 PA Route 100, Breinigsville, Lehigh County. Manager Bianco visited the Fairfield Inn and verified the informal complaint by asking for a taxi service and receiving Respondent’s business card, which bore “A-1 Allentown Taxi” and identical contact information to a business card previously collected by I&E Motor Carrier Enforcement.

19. On or about March 21, 2025, I&E Motor Carrier Enforcement Officer Reynaldo Pierluisse contacted Respondent via telephone to arrange for transportation for one passenger from Cedar Crest Giant, Allentown, Lehigh County, to 532 N. 15th Street, Allentown, Lehigh County, on March 21, 2025. Within an hour of requesting service, a black Infiniti sedan, bearing PA registration number LTP8729, arrived but abruptly left the location.⁶

20. Officer Pierluisse subsequently called Respondent to determine the status of the taxi to which Respondent advised contacting “True Service” to request taxi service.

21. Officer Pierluisse followed up with Respondent via email and telephone to request the identity of the driver of the black Infiniti sedan. Respondent answered the telephone call, and Officer Pierluisse informed Respondent of potential misdemeanor charges for operating without PUC authority, pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 3302.

B. May 8, 2025

22. On or about May 8, 2025, Officer Pierluisse contacted Respondent via telephone to arrange for transportation for one passenger from Cedar Beach Park, Allentown, Lehigh County, on May 8, 2025. Officer Pierluisse has interacted with Respondent before, and it is believed and therefore averred that Respondent is familiar with Officer Pierluisse. The individual who answered the phone advised transportation would arrive within ten minutes. When no car arrived within ten minutes, Officer Pierluisse telephoned Respondent again with no answer, and the voicemail message indicated the telephone number was associated with “A-1 Allentown Taxi”.

The results of the search revealed that the vehicle was registered to Respondent.

23. Within an hour of requesting service, a silver Ford Fusion, bearing PA registration number TX51768, a taxi dome light, and “Premium Taxi LLC PUC A-00121698” vehicle markings, arrived. The driver, Juan Florencio Tejada, reported receiving a call requesting transportation from Cedar Beach Park. Officer Pierluisse subsequently completed a vehicle inspection, whereupon Mr. Tejada provided his driver’s license, vehicle registration, trip logs, and mobile phone call history.

24. Following the incident on May 8, 2025, Officer Pierluisse submitted a request to the Pennsylvania Criminal Intelligence Center (“PaCIC”) seeking information related to the phone numbers, individuals, and business entities related to the investigation of Respondent. Based on the phone numbers provided by PaCIC in connection with Respondent, Officer Pierluisse confirmed that the phone number that placed the call with Premium Taxi, LLC was associated with Respondent.

C. August 14, 2025

25. On or around August 14, 2025, Officer Pierluisse contacted Respondent via telephone to arrange for transportation for one passenger from the Allentown Fairgrounds, Allentown, Lehigh County, to Cedar Crest Hospital, Allentown, Lehigh County, on August 14, 2025. The individual who answered the call identified the business as “taxi” and advised that transportation would arrive in five minutes. Within an hour of requesting service, a black, 2012 Infiniti G25X⁷, bearing PA registration number LTP8729, vehicle identification number ending in the last 4 digits 2048, and occupied by a male driver and female passenger, arrived.

Officer Pierluisse identified himself as an I&E Motor Carrier Enforcement Officer and commenced a vehicle inspection, despite the vehicle occupants' noncompliance.⁸

26. On or about September 4, 2025, Officer Pierluisse filed a criminal complaint, docketed at MJ-31103-CR-0000180-2025, alleging a violation of 66 Pa.C.S. § 3302.⁹

Respondent's Preliminary Hearing is currently scheduled for June 17, 2026. *See* I&E Exhibit 3.

IV. VIOLATION

27. All allegations in paragraphs 1-26 are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

28. That Respondent, by providing, furnishing, contracting, procuring, or arranging passenger transportation service for compensation between points in Pennsylvania on March 21, 2025, May 8, 2025, and August 14, 2025, while not having operating authority with this Commission violated 66 Pa.C.S. § 1101 and/or 66 Pa.C.S. § 2505(a). (3 counts).

V. RELIEF REQUESTED

29. Based on the foregoing allegations, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that Respondent be directed as detailed below:

- a. That Respondent be ordered to pay a civil penalty of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for the above-described violations, pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 3301;
- b. That the Commission certify Respondent's automobile registrations, including PA registration number LTP8729, to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for suspension or revocation, pursuant to 75 Pa.C.S. § 1375;

The female passenger, who provided the name "Tosha Greene," a date of birth, address, and phone number, could not be verified through either the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Law Enforcement Assistance Network ("CLEAN") or the Pennsylvania Justice Network ("JNET").

- c. That Respondent cease and desist from providing unauthorized passenger transportation for compensation;
- d. That the Commission refer this matter to the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General for appropriate action should Respondent fail to pay the civil penalty upon Order of the Commission; and
- e. That the Commission grant such other relief as the Commission deems appropriate.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission respectfully requests that, after consideration of the record, the Office of Administrative Law Judge and the Commission find Hassana L. Sessoms t/a A-1 Allentown Taxi LLC in violation of the counts as set forth herein and grant the relief specified above.




