PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

A Prehearing Conference is scheduled for **Monday, June 15, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.** The Office of Administrative Law Judge inadvertently issued a Prehearing Order for Telephone Hearing on April 22, 2026, which Order has been **RESCINDED** and **REMOVED** from the docket in this proceeding, as improperly issued. The following Prehearing Conference Order takes the place of that Order.

At the Prehearing Conference on June 15, 2026, the undersigned administrative law judge will preside telephonically. To participate in the conference, you must dial the toll-free number listed below. You will be prompted to enter a Passcode number, which is also listed below. You will be asked to speak your name and then the telephone system will connect you to the conference.

You must call into the conference on the scheduled day and time. Failure of any party to attend the prehearing conference without good cause shall constitute a waiver of all objections to the agreements reached and matters decided at the prehearing conference. You will not be called by the Administrative Law Judge.

The parties are hereby directed to comply with the following requirements:

1. Each party must file and serve, prior to **12:00 p.m. on Friday, June 12, 2026**, a Prehearing Conference Memorandum which sets forth the issues you intend to present, a proposed plan and schedule of discovery, a listing of your proposed witnesses and the subject of their testimony, and a proposed litigation schedule, agreed to by all parties if possible. 52 Pa.Code § 5.222(d). Receipt may be accomplished by electronic mail transmission to the presiding officer at kdunderdal@pa.gov.

2. A request for a change of the scheduled prehearing conference date must state the agreement or opposition of other parties and must be emailed to the presiding officer and all parties no later than five (5) business days prior to the prehearing conference. 52 Pa.Code § 1.15(b). For your convenience, a copy of the Commission's current service list of all parties (with available email addresses) is attached to this Order. A change in the prehearing conference date may be granted for good cause shown.

In accordance with the foregoing, absent a continuance for good cause, all parties must be prepared to participate in the scheduled Prehearing Conference.

3. Please review the regulations pertaining to prehearing conferences, 52 Pa.Code § 5.221-§ 5.224, and in particular, § 5.222(d) which provides, in part:

(d) Parties and counsel will be expected to attend the conference fully prepared for a useful discussion of all problems involved in the proceeding, both procedural and substantive, and fully authorized to make commitments with respect thereto.

(1) The preparation must include submission of a prehearing memorandum and list:

- (i) The presently identified issues.
- (ii) The names and addresses of the witnesses.
- (iii) The proposed area of testimony of each witness.

(2) The preparation may include:

- (i) Development of a proposed procedural schedule.
- (ii) Advance study of all relevant materials.
- (iii) Advance informal communication between the parties, including requests for additional data and information, to the extent it appears feasible and desirable.

(Emphasis added.)

4. Parties should review the regulations relating to discovery, specifically 52 Pa.Code §5.331(b), which provides, *inter alia*, that “a party shall endeavor to initiate discovery as early in the proceedings as reasonably possible,” and 52 Pa.Code § 5.322, which encourages parties to exchange information on an informal basis. All parties are urged to cooperate in discovery, and advise us at the prehearing conference as to discovery problems which have not been resolved. There are limitations on discovery and sanctions for abuse of the discovery process. 52 Pa.Code §§ 5.361, 5.371-5.372.

5. Pursuant to 52 Pa.Code §§ 1.21 & 1.22, you may represent yourself, if you are an individual, or you may have an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or admitted *Pro Hac Vice*, represent you. However, **if you are a partnership, corporation, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision**, you must have an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or admitted *Pro Hac Vice*, represent you in this proceeding. Unless you are an attorney, you may not represent someone else. Attorneys shall insure that their appearance is entered in accordance with the provisions of 52 Pa.Code § 1.24(b).

6. Failure of a party to attend the prehearing conference, or notify the presiding officer of a desire to fully participate without good cause shown, shall constitute a waiver of all objections to the agreements reached and matters decided at the prehearing
