## **ISSUES TO BE ADDRESSED**

PIOGA intends to address the following issues:

- A. The proposed AGS fee increase and the alleged decline in conventional production in the PNG system.
- B. The costs related to the PNG gathering system and the proposed infrastructure improvements and costs associated therewith.
- C. The effect of any proposed rate and/or AGS increase or rate structure on the classes of customers and producers, (1) particularly low-income residential customers and (2) producers within the PNG system.

PIOGA reserves the right to address other issues that may affect the interests of PIOGA and its producer and natural gas supplier ("NGS") members as well as to address issues raised by other parties that may affect those interests.

PIOGA has reviewed the procedural schedule contained within the Prehearing Conference Memorandum submitted by PNG and has no objection to the same.


PIOGA further does not oppose any public input hearings occurring.


