

Request for Information

- 1.) For the Public Utility Commission to get a better understanding of your proposed transportation services. Please explain where your transportation clients will come from. Meaning, will this service be open to the public or will all transportation clients be receiving home health care services from Hands to Hands LLC?

- Note: The requirements, oversight, and restrictions on transportation for non-home health care clients (the public) are considerably higher than transportation services offered only to your existing / concurrent home healthcare clients.

- 2.) Please provide an explanation as to how you believe your company is equipped to provide services in such a large operating area with no Company vehicle.
 - At this point it is expected that the Company is fully funded and ready to commence operations.

- 3.) Based on the balance Sheet's cash assets of \$5,000, Hands to Hands LLC lacks the financial position to gain a Certificate of Public Convenience. To show improvement financial fitness you should have substantial assets amount to cover any unforeseen costs, such as acquiring vehicles, maintenance, insurance coverage, and possible fines.
 - It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service.

- Please provide supporting documentation for improved financial fitness. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of Hands to Hands LLC. (account numbers may be redacted).
- 4.) Please specify what the \$2,000 represents in the other current assets designation on the balance sheet.

As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your

consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged.
