Dear Secretary Homsher:

Enclosed for filing is Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC’s (“Peoples”) Petition to Amend the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) Opinion and Order issued March 26, 2026. Peoples’ Petition to Amend is limited in nature and requests an additional 30-day timeframe in which to comply with Ordering Paragraph 7. Ordering Paragraph 7 states:

7. That Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC shall make a donation in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to Tyrone, PA, area fire departments for the purchase and distribution of methane detectors to local businesses and residents. Said donation shall be made within thirty (30) days of date of entry of the final Commission Order in this proceeding, and the Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC shall notify the Commission’s Secretary, once said donation is made. The donation shall not be passed through as an additional charge to Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC’s customers in Pennsylvania.

Peoples Petition to Amend respectfully requests that the Commission amend Ordering Paragraph 7 as follows:

7. That Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC shall make a donation in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to Tyrone, PA, area fire departments for the purchase and distribution of methane detectors to local businesses and residents. Said donation shall be made within ~~thirty (30)~~ **sixty (60)** days of date of entry of the final Commission Order in this proceeding, and the Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC shall notify the Commission’s Secretary, once said donation is made. The donation shall not be passed through as an additional charge to Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC’s customers in Pennsylvania.

Peoples has communicated this request to counsel for the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and they do not oppose Peoples request as stated in the instant Petition to Amend.

**PEOPLES NATURAL GAS COMPANY LLC’S PETITION TO AMEND THE
PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION’S OPINION AND ORDER
ISSUED MARCH 26, 2026**

NOW COMES Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC (“Peoples”) and, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.41, petitions to amend a specific Ordering Paragraph 7 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s Opinion and Order issued March 26, 2026. In support of its Petition, Peoples states as follows:

1. The name and address of petitioner are Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC, 375 North Shore Drive, Pittsburgh, PA 15212.
2. The name and address of applicant’s attorney are Meagan Moore, 375 North Shore Drive, Suite 400 Pittsburgh, PA 15212.
3. By Opinion and Order dated March 26, 2026, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) approved a Joint Settlement between the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and Peoples, and directed Peoples to:

“make a donation in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to Tyrone, PA, area fire departments for the purchase and distribution of methane detectors to local businesses and residents. Said donation shall be made within thirty (30) days of date of entry of the final Commission Order in this proceeding, and the Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC shall notify the Commission’s Secretary, once said donation is made. The donation shall not be passed through as an additional charge to Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC’s customers in Pennsylvania.”
4. Peoples requests an additional 30 days within which to work with the Tyrone, PA area fire departments to facilitate the donation of \$50,000 for the purchase and distribution of methane detectors.
5. Accordingly, Peoples respectfully requests an additional thirty (30) calendar days to complete its obligation and that Ordering Paragraph 7 of the Commission Opinion and Order dated March 26, 2026 be modified as follows:
 7. That Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC shall make a donation in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to Tyrone, PA, area fire departments for the purchase and distribution of methane detectors to local businesses and residents. Said donation shall be made within ~~thirty (30)~~ **sixty (60)** days of date of entry of the final Commission Order in this proceeding, and the Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC shall notify the Commission’s Secretary, once said donation is made. The donation shall not be passed through as an additional charge to Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC’s customers in Pennsylvania.
6. Peoples has consulted with the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and they do not oppose Peoples instant Petition to Amend.

Wherefore, Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC requests that the Commission's Ordering Paragraph 7 of its Opinion and Order in this matter, dated March 26, 2026, be modified to allow for a sixty (60) day compliance period.
