¹ FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA”) was formed through the combination of several predecessor Pennsylvania electric utilities after approval by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC”). On January 1, 2024, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company (“Penelec”), Pennsylvania Power Company and West Penn Power Company (collectively, the “Predecessor Companies”) merged into FE PA . Consistent with the approvals received from the PUC, FE PA was certificated as a public utility and authorized to provide public utility service in the territories of the Predecessor Companies.
