To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your Application, Docket No. A-2026-3061672 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience **WILL NOT BE GRANTED** for the following reason(s):

On April 16, 2026, the applicant was issued a 10-day data request in response to its April 14, 2026, application for paratransit authority. The applicant was requested to provide an acceptable territory description, evidence of appropriate hiring/retention policies, appropriate safety/maintenance policies, and evidence of financial fitness. In the Commission's request, the applicant was provided guidance, examples, and citations to assist it in fully addressing each issue.

The applicant submitted its response on the same day as the Commission's request. In its response, the applicant satisfactorily addressed the previous issues related to territory and safety/maintenance. However, it has been determined that the applicant's revised hiring/retention policies remain inadequate and out of compliance with 52 Pa Code § 29.504 (Driver history/record retention), and § 29.505 (Criminal history schedule/record retention). There also remains the possibility of non-compliance with the requirements of 52 Pa Code § 29.503 (Driver age), unless it is the applicant's intention to hire emergency medical services vehicle operator (EMSVO) certified drivers for its non-emergency services. The hiring of such drivers is not alluded to or referenced to at any point in the applicant's filings in support of its application.

Additionally, the applicant states that it is presently unable to furnish the requested revised balance sheet and the corresponding evidence of financial fitness. In its response, the applicant has indicated that it has yet complete the capitalization of the entity – this is a task that should be completed prior to requesting authority to operate.

As such, the applicant has failed to establish that it possesses the policies or resources to provide safe, efficient, or reasonable transportation to the public.

**For these reasons the application is DISMISSED and DENIED**

### **APPEAL RIGHTS**

**ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission must open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by overnight delivery. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by overnight delivery.**

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration of Staff Action to: Secretary, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§-1.31 and 5.44.


