TURN and CAUSE-PA Letter in Lieu of Answer to PECO's Petition to Withdraw

Dear Secretary Homsher:

Please accept this letter in support of the Petition of PECO Energy Company to withdraw Tariff No. 9 in the above-referenced proceeding. Copies of this Letter will be circulated in accordance with the attached Certificate of Service.

On March 30, 2026, PECO submitted a rate filing seeking a rate increase. On April 7, 2026, TURN and CAUSE-PA filed a Formal Complaint to this rate filing. On April 16, 2026, PECO filed a petition to withdraw its electricity rate increase filing.¹ TURN and CAUSE-PA support PECO's Petition to Withdraw. PECO's proposed rate increase, initially filed less than a month ago, would have increased the monthly bill of a residential customer using 700 kWh per month by \$20.08 to \$180.45.² This rate increase would have imposed severe hardship on low and moderate income residential customers, many of whom are unable to afford bills at PECO's current rates.

PECO filed its rate increase requests despite recent findings by the Commission's Bureau of Audits in its February 2026 Management and Efficiency Investigation that PECO's Customer Information System is causing a degradation in customer service performance metrics, has led to challenges in addressing customer needs, and led to multiple inquiries related to customers not receiving regular bills.³

PECO also filed this rate increase request despite the fact that in 2025, between January and November, PECO terminated residential service to 126,734 households.⁴ This is an increase from 2023, when PECO Electric terminated service to 87,430 households.⁵ PECO stated both in its filing and when withdrawing its filing that PECO is focused on energy affordability.⁶ Rising termination rates demonstrate that PECO customers struggle to afford gas and electric service under current rates. Yet another rate increase would only compound existing rate unaffordability, most acutely for PECO's low and moderate income customers. PECO's Petition to Withdraw its rate increase request is therefore in the public interest.

TURN and CAUSE-PA support PECO's Petition to Withdraw and look forward to continuing to work with PECO on customer service and affordability issues.
