
Dear Parties:

On April 27, 2026, SFE Energy Pennsylvania, Inc. (SFE) filed a petition for a 30-day extension of time in which to file a response to Complainant's Formal Complaint. The original response is due April 19, 2026. In its petition, SFE avers that it needs additional time to engage in settlement discussions with Complainant. SFE's petition fails to indicate whether Complainant supports or opposes the extension, or whether SFE contacted Complainant to obtain Complainant's consent to the extension.

Because this is SFE's first request for an extension, and because the extension is being sought to provide the parties time to fully engage in settlement discussion, SFE's petition for an extension of 30 days to file its responsive pleading to the above captioned Formal Complaint is granted. Any further requests for extensions should include a statement that all parties were consulted about the extension and whether or not any party has any objections to the extension.

SFE's Answer and any other responsive pleadings are due to be filed with the Commission by the close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) on May 29, 2026.
