REPRESENTATION. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself or you may have an attorney represent you. All others, including a partnership, corporation, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted *pro hac vice*. Only an attorney may represent someone else. Attorneys must file an entry of appearance with the Commission prior to the hearing.

PRESENTING EXHIBITS. If you intend to present any documents or exhibits at the hearing, you must email one (1) copy to the Administrative Law Judge at efarren@pa.gov and one (1) copy each must be sent to every other party. All copies must be received by 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 9, 2026. Proposed exhibits should be properly pre-marked for identification purposes.

ACCOMMODATION. Any party who needs an accommodation for a disability in order to participate in this hearing process may request one. Please call the Office of Administrative Law Judge (OALJ) scheduling office at least five (5) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.
