Please find attached Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 13, effective June 1, 2026 (this tariff cancels Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 12), for Weleski Transfer, Inc. (PA PUC Certificate #A-00096502), P. O. Box 428, Tarentum PA 15084.

Changes to this tariff are an **INCREASE** in local hourly rates, a **CHANGE** in Note 5 on Page 9 regarding the application of hourly rates after 6:00PM, and a **CHANGE** in the application of the travel time charge for local moves (shipments transported 40 miles or less).

SECTION 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

Item 5 - Scope of Carrier's Operating Authority

Rates and provisions named in this tariff are to transport household goods, in use, between points in Pennsylvania.

Item 10 - Governing Publications

This tariff is governed, except as otherwise provided, by the following described publication(s) and supplements thereto and reissues thereof.

(a) Mileage Guide No. 40, Pa. P.U.C. No. 40, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent, or computer software program designed to calculate mileages, such as, Google Maps or MapQuest, for determination of mileages (distances).

(b) Carrier Directory No. 53, Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent, for rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise provided herein.

Item 15 - Definition of Holidays

The term "holiday" as used herein shall mean New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day or any other day generally observed as a holiday by the carrier at the point at which the service is performed.

Item 20 - Declared Value

Rates and charges named herein applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For method of determining rates when value declared exceeds sixty (60) center per pound per article, see Conversion Table of Rates, Section 4 of Governing Publication.

SECTION 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

Item 25 - Classification of Property

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property; except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and transportation charges paid to the carrier by, the householder.

Item 30 - Booking Commission

Weleski Transfer requests the permission to implement a 20% booking commission on the line haul portion of all intrastate PA shipments moving in excess of forty (40) miles that are booked for the privilege of a third party relocation company and/or intrastate PA move requests of over forty (40) miles made by a foreign agent. This additional booking commission will not be levied upon any shipment sold by and booked by the Weleski Transfer sales force.

Item 35 - Cancellation of Services

Weleski Transfer, Inc. reserves the right to charge cancellation fees in the following amounts:

On jobs cancelling within twenty-four (24) hours of scheduled start time, shipper will be charged two (2) hours for labor and equipment at the estimated hourly rates.

On jobs cancelling less than forty-eight (48) but not more than twenty-four (24) hours of scheduled start time, shipper will be charged one (1) hour for labor and equipment at the estimated hourly rates.

Item 40 - Waiver of Minimum Charge

Carrier shall not assess a minimum charge (number of hours) whenever a move takes less time than the minimum number of hours filed and said move is performed solely at the carrier's convenience. In such instances, the carrier shall charge based on the actual time necessary to complete the move plus the applicable travel time charge.

SECTION 2 - ADDITIONAL SERVICES

SECTION 3 - HOURLY RATES

ITEM 200

Applicable on the transportation of CLASS 1 (Item 25) SHIPMENTS transported distances of forty (40) miles and less. Subject to NOTES

AA and 1 to 6 below. The transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in COLUMN 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Column 2, 3 and 4. Hourly rates apply only from the time of arrival of the vehicles and men at the first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from the first point of origin to the final destination, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of the vehicles and men by the shipper at destination.

SECTION 3 - HOURLY RATES

(continued from previous page)

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to Hourly Rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly Rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days, or period of days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly Rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are computed in half-hour periods. Fractions of one-half hour are considered as one-half hour.

NOTE 4 - Minimum transportation charge: Sundays and Holidays (any hour): 8 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 3. Other than Sundays and Holidays (any hour): 4 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2 or Columns 1 and 4.

▲ NOTE 5 - Carrier reserves the right to charge rates in Column 2 for any weekday job that runs continuously through 6:00PM for any hours after 6:00PM or for any weekday job that begins after 5:00PM.

NOTE 6 - Carrier will supply and charge for a minimum of one supervisor when 8 or more men (drivers, helpers, packers) are employed on the job; two supervisors when 13 or more men are employed. On the request of the shipper, carrier will supply and charge for supervisors in addition to these minimums.

▲ NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined mileage from carrier's terminal to first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter.

0 - 20 miles	1 hour
21 - 30 miles	1 1/2 hours
31 - 40 miles	2 hours

For mileage in excess of 40 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 20 miles or portion thereof.
