Dear Parties:

On March 27, 2026, Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC filed proposed Original Tariff Gas – Pa PUC No. 49 and Original Tariff Gas – Pa PUC No. S-5 seeking a change in its rates, rules, and regulations. On April 16, 2026, the Commission entered an Order suspending the proposed tariffs and instituted an investigation to determine the lawfulness, justness, and reasonableness of the rates, rules, and regulations contained in the proposed tariffs. This matter is still currently pending before the Commission.

On April 30, 2026, the Commission received a letter from State Senator Wayne Langerholc, Jr. Senator Langerholc's letter was addressed to Commission Chairman, Stephen DeFrank, and carbon copied to the remaining Commissioners of the Commission. Senator Langerholc's letter contains statements and additional averments regarding the issues being litigated in the above-referenced case.

Because the subject matter of Senator Langerholc's letter concerns the merits of a contested matter still pending before the Commission for final consideration, Senator Langerholc's letter constitutes an ex parte communication prohibited by Section 334(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 334(c). Accordingly, please be advised that, in order to cure the ex parte communication, I am placing Senator Langerholc's Letter on the docket and serving a copy of this Secretarial Letter and Senator Langerholc's letter on all the Parties of Record to this case.
