**Re: Docket No. P-2022-3032929
Petition of the Officer of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Pennsylvania Utility Law Project Requesting Initiation of a Proceeding on Federal Funding Opportunities for Utilities Under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act**

Dear Secretary Homsher:

On June 10, 2022, the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Pennsylvania Utility Law Project (collectively, “Petitioners”) filed a Petition with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.41, requesting that the Commission initiate a proceeding to require utilities and allow interested parties to file reports and comments to the Commission related to federal programs and funding available to Pennsylvania utilities under the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act¹ (“IIJA”) (Petition).

On June 23, 2022, the Secretary of the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter further serving the Petition on all Pennsylvania jurisdictional fixed utilities, and setting July 25, 2022, as the deadline for responsive pleadings.

The Commission entered an Order on March 21, 2023 (“Order”), requiring all fixed public utilities subject to Commission jurisdiction which received funding from IIJA sources to provide a report pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 504 by April 30 of each year, with the requirement expiring on May 1, 2027.


