The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's letter in lieu of the Retail Market Enhancement Surcharge (RMES) filing submitted on April 1, 2026. The letter indicates that the rate will remain unchanged at zero.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed RMES rate for the twelve-month period of June 1, 2026 through May 31, 2027 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to remain effective as filed.

The RMES is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
