**PUBLIC STATEMENT OF
THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interest of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50 (the “Act”). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by her initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a Notice of Intervention in the above-captioned Commission proceeding.

On April 7, 2026, a Joint Application for all of the Authority and Necessary Certificates of Public Convenience for the Indirect Transfer of Control of Energy Center Harrisburg LLC and Energy Center Pittsburgh LLC Concerning the Upstream Internal Restructuring of KKR & Co. Inc. was filed with the Commission.

The Small Business Advocate is intervening in this proceeding to protect the interests of Energy Center’s small business customers. A thorough inquiry by the Commission into all the

elements of the Joint Application is necessary to ascertain whether it conforms to the Public Utility Code and the Commission's regulations.

In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate is requesting that the Joint Application be subject to investigation and evidentiary hearings before the Commission. The Small Business Advocate will ask the Commission to deny or modify any aspect of the Joint Application that is not proven to be just, reasonable, non-discriminatory, and fully in accordance with the Public Utility Code and the Commission's regulations.
