**UNOPPOSED MOTION OF UGI UTILITIES, INC. – GAS DIVISION FOR  
SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSIVE PLEADINGS**

---

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(a)(1), UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (“UGI Gas” or the “Company”), by its counsel, hereby requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) further extend the current due date to file responsive pleadings to the above-captioned Formal Complaint of the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) by fourteen (14) days (e.g., from May 7, 2026, to May 21, 2026). **UGI Gas further requests that this request be reviewed on an expedited basis and granted as soon as possible, but no later than May 6, 2026.** In support thereof, UGI Gas represents as follows:

1. On March 18, 2026, UGI Gas was served with the above-captioned Formal Complaint. Under the Commission’s regulations, any UGI Gas responsive pleadings (e.g., Answer or Preliminary Objections) to the Formal Complaint would be due on April 7, 2026.

2. On April 1, 2026, UGI Gas filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Responsive Pleadings in this matter, after conferring with counsel from I&E regarding this motion.

3. On April 3, 2026, the Commission approved the Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Responsive Pleadings in this matter by Secretarial Letter. Therein, UGI Gas was granted an extension of time to file responsive pleadings until May 7, 2026.

4. Counsel for UGI Gas has a number of additional conflicting deadlines and required appearances between the date the Formal Complaint was served and the date such responsive pleadings are due, which are the result of counsel covering appearances and matters on behalf of a colleague that has experienced a significant medical issue and is out on leave.

5. Counsel for UGI Gas contacted counsel for I&E to determine whether I&E would object to a further extension of time to file responsive pleadings to the Formal Complaint. Counsel for I&E indicated that I&E does not oppose a further fourteen (14) day extension, which would make UGI Gas's Answer to the Formal Complaint due on May 21, 2026.

6. Section 1.15(a)(1) of the Commission's regulations states:

...whenever under this title or by order of the Commission, or notice given thereunder, an act is required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time, the time fixed or the period of time prescribed may, by the Commission, the presiding officer or other authorized person, for good cause be extended upon motion made before expiration of the period originally prescribed or as previously extended.

52 Pa. Code § 1.15(a)(1). As such, the Commission, the presiding officer or other authorized person, may grant a request for an extension of time, prior to the originally prescribed deadline, upon a showing of "good cause."

7. Good cause for the requested extension exists because it will provide UGI Gas with additional, necessary time to respond to the Formal Complaint. It will also avoid additional, previously unforeseen conflicts for UGI Gas's counsel. In addition, the request will not unnecessarily delay this matter, and UGI Gas's request is not opposed by I&E.

8. For these reasons, UGI Gas submits good cause exists for the requested 14-day extension and that it will help secure the just, speedy and efficient determination of the above-captioned matter.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division requests that Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, the Presiding Officer or another authorized person grant this Motion and further extend the time for UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division to file any responsive pleadings to the above-captioned Formal Complaint until May 21, 2026. **UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division further requests that this request be reviewed on an expedited basis and granted as soon as possible, but no later than May 6, 2026.**
