Dear Parties:

On May 4, 2026, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (UGI) filed a second unopposed motion for an extension of time until May 21, 2026, to file a response to Complainant’s Formal Complaint. The original response was due April 7, 2026. UGI’s first request for an extension was granted extending the response date to May 7, 2026.

In its current motion, counsel for UGI avers that as a result of having to “cover[] appearances and matters on behalf of a colleague that has experienced a significant medical issue and is out on leave[,]” he is unable to timely file a responsive pleading to Complainant’s Complaint. See UGI Motion ¶4. UGI also indicated that Complainant does not object to the extension. See UGI Motion ¶5.

UGI is granted an extension of time to file its responsive pleading to the above captioned Formal Complaint.

UGI’s Answer and any other responsive pleadings are due to be filed with the Commission by the close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) on May 21, 2026.
