We are in receipt of the Tentative Order dated April 16, 2026 and submit our comments as requested.

Perry Co. Excavating & Paving, LLC is a woman-owned small business based in Central PA, proudly holding certifications as an SDB, SB, DBE, SBE, WBE, WOSB, and EDWOSB. Since 2010 we have held our Certificate of Public Convenience. We haul for Pennsy Supply, J.D. Eckman, and the former Hempt Bros. all of which require hired haulers to have this certification. Compliance with this requirement has been vital to our continued operations, and the potential revocation of this certificate poses a significant risk that could jeopardize our ability to partner with these entities and, ultimately, threaten the survival of our small business.

For the past 16 years, we have diligently complied with all P.U.C. requirements and regulatory standards to the best of our understanding. Our operations have remained consistently uninterrupted, and we have submitted all mandatory reports well in advance of the deadlines, often filing them at least a month ahead of schedule.

Despite our diligent efforts to fulfill all expectations, a lack of understanding or clarity has led to our inclusion on this list. At no point did we receive a notice of noncompliance or the opportunity to remedy any issues or errors. Over the years, we have attempted to seek advice or guidance from the P.U.C., but our phone calls went unanswered. On a few occasions, I personally reached out to the officer who conducted our initial investigation, seeking clarification. I can only suspect the matter may arise from a misunderstanding related to the exemptions allowed under the P.U.C. guidelines.

The materials transported for the aforementioned companies, along with others, consist of excavated materials and road construction products that are categorized as exempt revenue under Section 4. Additionally, other products we transport fall under the exemption outlined in Section 5. However, I inadvertently overlooked materials hauled for a parking lot project completed by NESL. Now recognizing this mistake, I have submitted a revised assessment (emailed to victwhite@pa.gov on May 1, 2026) for 2025, to rectify the error.

The most alarming aspect of this Order lies in the potential suspension of our vehicle registrations, as outlined in Section 5. Such an action would not only pose significant financial hardship but could also irreparably harm my small business and potentially lead to bankruptcy. As a Disadvantaged Woman-Owned business in this challenging industry, the obstacles are already immense, the loss of registrations – and consequently work – could be a setback from which recovery may be impossible. I respectfully plead with you to consider allowing us to retain our Certificate of Public Convenience and to provide clarity on the specific issue that put us at risk. This will enable us to address and remediate the concerns and prevent them from happening in the future.

All either placed on roads or stockpiles for those jobs. Tire adjusted all but \$4,215<sup>00</sup> of the hauling income because it was probably product hauled to B&E.

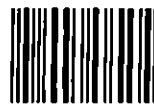

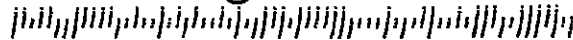
