To whom it may concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your application for Paratransit authority at Docket No. A-2026-3061533 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience shall not be granted for the following reason(s):

- **Failure to establish fitness.** Under 52 Pa. Code §41.14(b), the Commission is to determine whether an applicant possesses the technical and financial ability to provide the proposed service. On April 14, 2026, the applicant was issued a data request directing them to provide clarification on their incomplete/inadequate answers to their verified statements in their original application dated April 6, 2026. In its request, the Commission provided the relevant statutory citations and relevant guidance for the applicant to reference when preparing its revisions. In response to the Commission's data request, the applicant has been unable to provide the following:
 - 1) A corrected, written territory proposal.
 - 2) Knowledge of business transportation whether by experience or education/training.
 - 3) Answers that address both driver history (schedule) and criminal history (schedule).
 - 4) Answers that address participation in the ODP waiver program and advertising regarding the proposed business.

Therefore, it has been determined that the applicant lacks the technical fitness required to provide safe, efficient, and reliable transportation.

- **Failure to establish financial fitness.** Under 52 Pa. Code §41.14(1), the Commission is to determine whether an applicant possesses the technical and financial ability to provide the proposed service. On April 14, 2026, the applicant was issued a data request directing them to provide a current statement of financial position. They were informed

that they should fully fund and equip the business prior to submitting their response, and that applicants lacking suitable finances, resources and equipment would be denied authority. In response, the applicant provided a bank deposit letter stating a balance of \$15,000.00 in cash assets, however, the purchase of 2 vehicles at auction that would meet the vehicle requirements per their proposed territory were budgeted at “around \$30,000.00”. In addition, the applicant failed to provide a projected annual premium for commercial paratransit coverage, which is necessary for consideration in the applicants operating costs. Therefore, it has been determined that the applicant lacks the financial fitness required to provide safe, efficient, and reliable transportation.

For this reason(s), your application is **DENIED** and **DISMISSED**.

APPEAL RIGHTS

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission are advised to open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by mail. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by mail.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. *See* 52 Pa. Code §§1.31 and 5.44. Below is a sample Verification:
