- 1.) An individual applying for Household Goods in Use authority must provide evidence of two years' experience working with a licensed household goods carrier, or the equivalent, as required by Title 52 Pa. Code §3.381(c)(1)(iii)(A)(II)(1-).
  - a. 1099 forms do not establish the length of time working for a licensed household good carrier. Please provide a signed statement from your previous employer(s) verifying the length of time you were employed by these carriers.
  - b. Have you been licensed to operate as a household goods carrier in another state, or in an interstate capacity? If so, how long have you been licensed to operate as a household goods carrier?
  
- 2.) You failed to answer Question #5 of the Verified Statement of Applicant. Please provide compliant policies/plans for the hiring/employment of prospective drivers. **Please review the regulations found in Title 52 Pa Code §31.134, Title 52 Pa Code §37.204, and 49 CFR §391 to see what is required of Household Goods in Use carriers.**
  - a. Your system for conducting criminal background checks;
    - i. How will you conduct criminal background checks?
      1. In your previous response you stated that criminal history checks are provided from the Dept of Motor Vehicle through services at Sinclair Moving & Storage.
        - a. Please explain how this will work exactly. And how will you acquire criminal background checks from the Dept of Motor Vehicles?
  - b. What type of on the road training/defensive driving training, if any, do you require?
    - i. In your previous response you said that you would conduct "off road" training. Please explain in more detail your driving training program.
      1. Did this mean to say on road training?
  - c. Your system for conducting driver license/history checks;
    - i. How often will you perform driver license/history checks?
      1. In your previous response you stated that you would conduct driver license/history checks when a potential driver was hired.
        - a. Will you only conduct checks on driving records once? If not, how often will you perform such checks. Please provide a policy for driving record checks that comply with the regulations found at 49 CFR §391.25.

- 3.) Please describe your vehicle safety program. Please include the following in your explanation:
- a. Your periodic vehicle maintenance plan.
    - i. In your previous response you stated that your periodic maintenance plan consisted of roadside weekly maintenance performed on trucks, which includes pre-trip inspections.
      1. Please provide in detail all preventative maintenance performed on your vehicles during these weekly checks, as well as what your pre-trip inspections entail.
