

Subject: WLK Contractors LLC – Docket No. M-2026-3061024 – Clarification Regarding Assessment Reporting and Proposed CPC Cancellation

Dear Secretary Homsher / PUC Staff,

WLK Contractors LLC is writing regarding the Tentative Order entered at Docket No. M-2026-3061024 concerning the proposed cancellation of Certificates of Public Convenience.

WLK Contractors LLC is an active operating business performing construction-related hauling and dump truck operations in Pennsylvania in connection with excavation and utility work projects. The company's operations primarily involve standing by at project sites while contractors excavate and replace underground pipes, temporarily holding and transporting excavated material as directed at the job site for disposal or replacement upon completion of the work.

The company filed annual motor carrier assessment reports. In completing those reports, the company understood certain dump truck revenue associated with transportation of excavated materials to be exempt/non-assessable revenue under the PUC's motor carrier assessment guidance. As a result, the company reported zero assessable intrastate operating revenue.

The company did not intend to indicate that it was dormant, inactive, or no longer operating under its authority. Rather, the company believed its operations/revenue fell within an exempt category for assessment purposes.

WLK Contractors LLC therefore objects to the proposed cancellation of its Certificate of Public Convenience at this time and respectfully requests the opportunity to clarify the reporting treatment applicable to its operations before any cancellation becomes final.

Please advise if amended filings, supplemental information, or any additional submissions are required.
