

**PRELIMINARY OBJECTION OF
UGI UTILITIES, INC. – GAS DIVISION TO THE
COMPLAINT OF PHILIP FRANCISCO**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

AND NOW, comes UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (“UGI Gas” or “Company”) and hereby files this Preliminary Objection, pursuant to the regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) at 52 Pa. Code § 5.101, and respectfully requests that the Commission dismiss the above-captioned Formal Complaint (“Complaint”) filed by Philip Francisco (“Complainant”) in its entirety because the Commission lacks subject matter jurisdiction due to the Complainant’s active Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding.

In support thereof, UGI Gas states as follows:

IX. BACKGROUND

1. UGI Gas is a “public utility” and a “natural gas distribution company” as those terms are defined under the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 102 and 2202, subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the Commission.

2. UGI Gas provides natural gas distribution service to approximately 650,000 customers, located primarily in south, central, and northeastern Pennsylvania.

3. On April 16, 2026, UGI Gas was served with the above-captioned Formal Complaint filed by the Complainant.

4. In the Complaint, the Complainant requests a payment agreement for the past due balance owed to UGI Gas for gas service. (Complaint ¶¶ 4-5.)

5. On April 15, 2024, the Complainant filed a Chapter 13 Bankruptcy Petition with the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania (“Chapter 13 Petition”).

6. The Chapter 13 Petition proceeding remains active as of the filing date of this Preliminary Objection.

7. A true and correct copy of the docket sheet for the Chapter 13 Petition proceeding is attached hereto as **Appendix A**.

8. UGI Gas herein files this Preliminary Objection to the Complaint. For the reasons explained below, UGI Gas respectfully requests that the Commission summarily dismiss the Complaint because the Complainant lacks subject matter jurisdiction due to the Complainant’s active Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding.

X. STANDARD OF REVIEW

9. Pursuant to the Commission’s regulations, preliminary objections in response to a pleading may be filed on several grounds, including:

- (1) Lack of Commission jurisdiction or improper service of the pleading initiating the proceeding.
- (2) Failure of a pleading to conform to this chapter or the inclusion of scandalous or impertinent matter.
- (3) Insufficient specificity of a pleading.
- (4) Legal insufficiency of a pleading.

- (5) Lack of capacity to sue, nonjoinder of a necessary party or misjoinder of a cause of action.
- (6) Pendency of a prior proceeding or agreement for alternative dispute resolution.
- (7) Standing of a party to participate in the proceeding.

52 Pa. Code § 5.101(a) (emphasis added).

10. In ruling on preliminary objections, the Presiding Officer must accept as true all well-pled allegations of material facts as well as all inferences reasonably deducible therefrom. *Stilp v. Cmwth.*, 910 A.2d 775, 781 (Pa. Cmwth. 2006) (citing *Dep't of Gen. Servs. v. Bd. of Claims*, 881 A.2d 14 (Pa. Cmwth. 2005)). However, the Presiding Officer need not accept as true conclusions of law, unwarranted inferences from facts, argumentative allegations, or expressions of opinion. *Stanton-Negley Drug Co. v. Dep't of Pub. Welfare*, 927 A.2d 671, 673 (Pa. Cmwth. 2007). Notwithstanding, any doubt must be resolved in favor of the non-moving party. *Stilp*, at 781.

11. In addition, the Presiding Officer must determine whether, based on the factual pleadings, if recovery is possible. *See Rok v. Flaherty*, 527 A.2d 211, 214 (Pa. Cmwth. 1987). Indeed, for preliminary objections to be sustained, it must appear with certainty that the law will permit no recovery. *See Stilp*, at 781; *Milliner v. Enck*, 709 A.2d 417, 418 (Pa. Super. 1998).

XI. PRELIMINARY OBJECTION

A. PRELIMINARY OBJECTION NO. 1 – THE COMMISSION LACKS SUBJECT MATTER JURISDICTION OVER THE COMPLAINT BECAUSE THE COMPLAINANT HAS AN ACTIVE CHAPTER 13 BANKRUTPCY PROCEEDING

12. UGI Gas incorporates by reference Paragraphs 1 through 11 as if fully set forth herein.

13. The Complaint should be dismissed because the Commission lacks subject matter jurisdiction due to the Complainant's active Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding.

14. “[I]t is well established that the Commission lacks jurisdiction to order a payment arrangement for a customer with an active Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding.” *Kessler v. PECO Energy Co.*, 2020 Pa. PUC LEXIS 277, at *10 (Order entered Mar. 18, 2020) (citing *Matronics v. West Penn Power Co.*, Docket No. C-2017-2617235 (Order entered Jan. 9, 2020)).

15. “Generally any bankruptcy petition filed pursuant to the U.S. Bankruptcy Code will operate as a stay and bars either the commencement or continuation of a judicial or administrative proceeding against the debtor where the proceeding was commenced prior to the start of the bankruptcy proceeding or to recover a claim against the debtor that arose before the commencement of the bankruptcy proceeding.” *Steele v. Metro. Edison Co.*, 2020 Pa. PUC LEXIS 444, at *11 (Order entered Aug. 27, 2020) (citing 11 U.S.C. § 362(a)(1)).

16. However, when there is an active Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding, the Commission lacks jurisdiction over both pre- and post-bankruptcy filing arrearages. *Danjou v. West Penn Power Co.*, Docket No. F-2018-3006430, pp. 8-9 (Order entered July 22, 2019) (“*Danjou*”) (citations omitted).

17. As the Commission explained in *Danjou*:

Since the nature of a Chapter 13 bankruptcy is an on-going repayment plan in which all of a debtor's assets (including property, income and debts acquired pre-petition and post-petition) are included in the debtor's estate under the exclusive control of the bankruptcy trustee, the Commission is without jurisdiction to issue an order that affects the disposition of the income or assets of a debtor who has an active Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding even where the subject of the payment arrangement is a post-petition arrearage.

Id. (emphasis added).

18. Here, the Complainant's Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding remains active as of the date of this Preliminary Objection. *See Appendix A.*

19. Further, the Complaint centers around the past due balance on the Complainant's account that accrued after the Chapter 13 Petition. (Complaint ¶ 5 Attachment.)

20. A substantive order on this Complaint could affect the disposition of the income or assets of the Complainant, thereby contravening *Daniou*.

21. Therefore, under well-established Commission precedent, the Commission lacks subject matter jurisdiction over the instant Complaint because: (1) he has an active Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding; and (2) the Complainant is raising issues concerning the past due balance associated with his gas account.

22. Thus, the Commission should dismiss the Complaint pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.101(a)(1) and (a)(4).

XII. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division respectfully requests that the above-captioned Formal Complaint filed by Philip Francisco be dismissed in its entirety pursuant 52 Pa. Code § 5.101(a)(1) and (a)(4).


