B. If you fail to answer this Complaint within twenty (20) days, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement will request that the Commission issue an Order imposing the administrative penalty and other requested relief.

C. You may elect not to contest this Complaint by paying the administrative penalty within twenty (20) days and performing the corrective actions, if any, set forth in the requested relief. A certified check, cashier’s check or money order should be payable to the “Commonwealth of Pennsylvania” and mailed to:

Your payment is an admission that you committed the alleged violations and an agreement to cease and desist from committing further violations. Upon receipt of your payment, the Complaint proceeding shall be closed.

D. If you file an Answer, which either admits or fails to deny the allegations of the Complaint, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement will request the Commission to issue an Order imposing the administrative penalty and granting the requested relief as set forth in the Complaint.

E. If you file an Answer which contests the Complaint, the matter will proceed before the assigned presiding Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. The Judge is not bound by the penalty set forth in the Complaint and may impose additional and/or alternative penalties as appropriate.

F. If you are a corporation, you must be represented by legal counsel. 52 Pa. Code § 1.21.

FORMAL COMPLAINT

NOW COMES the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, by its prosecuting attorneys, pursuant to Section 182 of the Underground Utility Line Protection Law (“UULPL” or “PA One Call Law”), Act of October 29, 2024, P.L. 1106, No. 127, 73 P.S. § 182.8(c)(2), and files this Formal Complaint (“Complaint”) against West Mayfield Borough (“West Mayfield” or “Respondent”) alleging violations of the PA One Call Law in connection with a failure to respond to an emergency excavation notification. In support of its Complaint, I&E respectfully avers as follows:

I. COMMISSION JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY

1. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”), with a mailing address of the Commonwealth Keystone Building, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate, *inter alia*, facility owners, within the Commonwealth pursuant to the PA One Call Law, Act of October 29, 2024, P.L. 1106, No. 127, 73 P.S. §§ 176 *et seq.*

2. Complainant is the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, which is the bureau established to take enforcement actions against public utilities and other

entities subject to the Commission’s jurisdiction pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 308.2(a)(11). *See also Implementation of Act 129 of 2008; Organization of Bureaus and Offices*, Docket No. M-2008-2071852 (August 11, 2011) (delegating authority to initiate proceedings that are prosecutory in nature to I&E).

4. Respondent is West Mayfield Borough, with a main mailing address of 4609 W. Eighth Avenue, Beaver Falls, PA 15010.

5. West Mayfield meets the definition of a “facility owner” pursuant to Section 176 of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 176.¹

6. A “line” or “facility” is defined in pertinent part as “... an underground pipe used in carrying, gathering, transporting or providing natural or artificial gas ...to one or more...consumers or customers of such service and the appurtenances thereto....” 73 P.S. § 176.

7. Section 177 of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 177, imposes duties on facility owners.

¹ “Facility owner” is defined as “the public utility or agency, political subdivision, municipality, authority, rural electric cooperative or other person or entity who or which owns or operates a line. The term does not include the Department of Transportation within a State highway right-of-way. The term does not include any of the following:

(1) A person serving the person's own property through the person's own line, if the person does not provide service to any other customer.

(2) A person using a line which the person does not own or operate, if the use of the line does not serve more than a single property.” 73 P.S. § 176.

8. Specifically, Section 177(5)(v) of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 177(5)(v), requires facility owners to “...in the case of an emergency, to respond *through the One Call System* as soon as practicable following receipt of notification of the emergency by the One Call System.” 73 P.S. § 177(5)(v)(emphasis added).

9. Respondent, as a facility owner, is subject to the power and authority of this Commission pursuant to Section 182.10 of the PA One Call Law, which requires facility owners to comply with the PA One Call Law. 73 P.S. § 182.10.

10. Section 182.8(c)-(d) and Section 182.10 of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. §§ 182.8(c)-(d) and 182.10, authorize the Commission to, *inter alia*, hear and determine complaints against facility owners for violations of the PA One Call Law and to enforce the provisions of the PA One Call Law. 73 P.S. §§ 182.8(c)-(d) and 182.10.

11. Section 182.8(c)(2) of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 182.8(c)(2), authorizes the Commission’s prosecutorial staff to bring a formal complaint against entities subject to the PA One Call Law. 73 P.S. § 182.8(c)(2).

12. Section 182.10 of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 182.10(b)(1)(i)-(ii), authorizes the Commission to impose administrative penalties on any person or corporation, subject to the PA One Call Law, who violates any provisions of the PA One Call Law or any regulation or order issued thereunder governing underground utility lines, of up to \$2,500 per violation or if the violation results in injury, death, or property damage of \$25,000 dollars or more, an administrative penalty not to exceed \$50,000. 73 P.S. § 182.10(b)(1)(i)-(ii).

13. Pursuant to the provisions of the applicable Commonwealth statutes and regulations, the Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Complaint and the actions of Respondent related thereto.

II. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

14. On February 20, 2025, at 10:17 AM, Beaver Falls Municipal Authority (“Beaver Falls”) submitted an emergency excavation ticket, serial number 20250511072 (“February 20 Ticket”), for the purpose of repairing a water mainline near 405 Patterson Avenue, West Mayfield Borough, Beaver County, PA. The February 20 Ticket is attached hereto as I&E Exhibit 1.

15. Responses to emergency excavation tickets must occur as soon as practicable following the notification and must be made through the One Call System. 73 P.S. § 177(5)(v).

16. West Mayfield did not respond on February 20, 2025. The One Call System automatically recorded West Mayfield as “No Response” at 12:21 PM.²

17. The following day, February 21, 2025, West Mayfield submitted a response at 1:42 AM as “Field Marked.”

18. West Mayfield’s response to the emergency excavation ticket occurred fifteen hours and twenty-eight minutes after the ticket was placed.

19. Beaver Falls began their emergency excavation at 10:30 AM on February 20, 2025. I&E Exhibit 1.

20. On February 21, 2025, at or around 12:30 AM Beaver Falls struck a marked 2-inch main gas line owned by Columbia Gas of PA Inc. (“Columbia Gas”).³

² When a facility owner does not give a final response in a timely manner, the One Call System will register in the ticket record “No Response.” In Emergency Work Location Requests, the system sends the response two hours after the notification is received.

³ For the February 21, 2025 line strike, Beaver Falls was found to have violated the PA One Call Law for failing to exercise due care and employ prudent excavation techniques, and failing to submit in Alleged Violation Report within 30 days of striking a line. Pennsylvania Damage Prevention Committee, *Informal Determination* (Aug. 15, 2025) (Case No. 053012).

21. At 1:40 AM on February 21, 2025, Columbia Gas submitted an emergency excavation ticket (“February 21 Ticket”) to repair the damaged gas line. At 1:46 AM, West Mayfield submitted the response “Not marked. No Access.”

22. West Mayfield’s response to the February 21 ticket occurred only three minutes after its response to the February 20 Ticket. The February 21 Ticket is attached hereto as I&E Exhibit 2.

23. While I&E does not claim Respondent is responsible for the February 21, 2025 gas line strike, the strike demonstrates that excavation work was substantially advanced before Respondent submitted the February 20 Ticket, strongly indicating the response was not made as soon as practicable.

24. On May 19, 2025, a copy of the report prepared by the Damage Prevention Investigator (“DPI”) from the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, Damage Prevention Section (“DPS”), was mailed to West Mayfield informing Respondent that it was in violation of the PA One Call Law by failing to respond to an emergency notification as soon as practicable following notification. The letter further informed Respondent that it could either accept the findings in the DPI’s report or reject them and present its case to the Damage Prevention Committee (“DPC”).

25. On May 31, 2025, Respondent rejected the finding of the DPI report via email.

26. On July 9, 2025, the DPS mailed Respondent a letter informing it that it could present its case at the August 12, 2025 DPC meeting, where its case would be discussed and voted upon. However, Respondent did not attend the DPC meeting and present its case.

27. On August 13, 2025, a copy of the DPC’s Informal Determination accepting the DPI’s report and imposing an administrative penalty was mailed to West Mayfield, informing

Respondent that it could either accept the DPC's Informal Determination or reject it in writing within thirty (30) days of the date of the notification letter, and that if the Informal Determination is rejected the case may be sent to I&E prosecutory staff for issuance of a formal complaint.

28. On September 11, 2025, West Mayfield rejected the DPC's Informal Determination via an email and U.S. first-class mail to the DPI.

III. VIOLATION

Paragraphs 1-28 are incorporated herein as if stated in their entirety. Respondent failed to respond to an emergency excavation ticket through the One Call System as soon as practicable following receipt of the notification. Here, Respondent received an emergency notification on February 20, 2025, at 10:17 AM. However, Respondent did not issue a proper response until February 21, 2025 at 1:42 AM – more than fifteen hours following receipt of the emergency notification.

If proven, this is a violation of 73 P.S. § 177(5)(v) of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 177(5)(v) (one count).

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement's proposed administrative penalty for this violation is \$2,000.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement respectfully requests that the Commission:

- (1) Find West Mayfield to be in violation of the PA One Call Law at 73 P.S. § 177 (5)(v);
- (2) Impose an administrative penalty upon West Mayfield in the amount of \$2,000, to be paid within 30 days of the date of a Commission Final Order;

- (3) Order West Mayfield to attend and pass the Facility Owner educational program and provide proof of compliance to the Commission within 30 days of the entry of a Final Commission Order;
- (4) Order such other remedies as the Commission may deem appropriate; and
- (5) If payment of the administrative penalty is not made as set forth, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement requests that this matter be referred to the Pennsylvania Office of the Attorney General for collection and any other appropriate action.



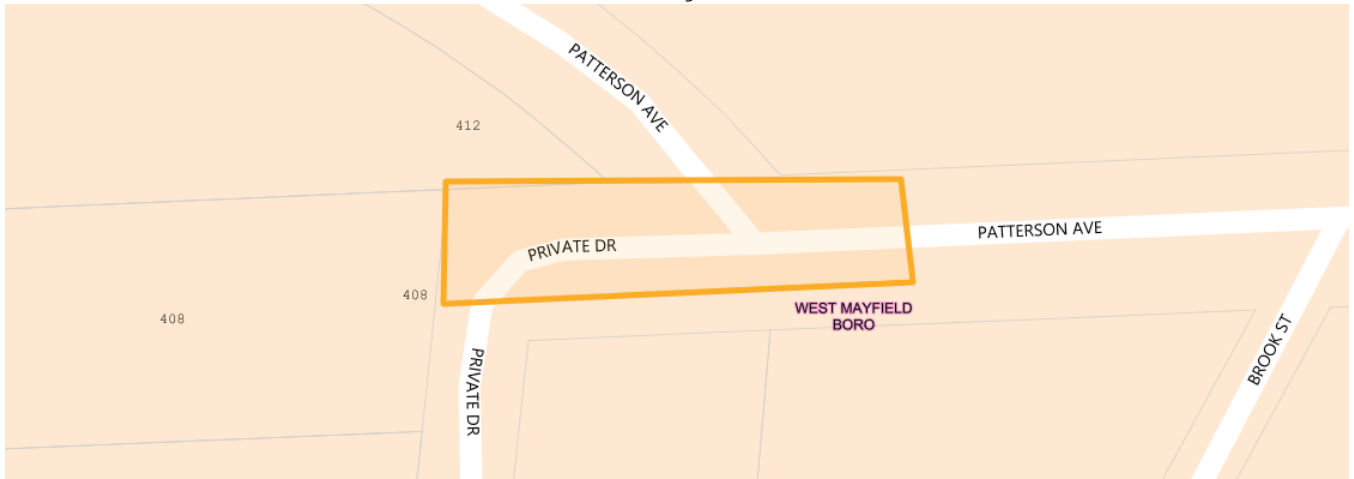
