**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY
FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA” or the “Company”) by and through its attorney, Timothy K. McHugh, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby files this Motion for Continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for February 11, 2026. In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. On or about March 12, 2026, Sylvester Thomas (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) regarding 238 North 12th Street, Reading, Pennsylvania 19604 (“Service Location”) under Account No. 100151891635 (“Account”).

2. On April 1, 2026, the Company filed its Answer denying the material allegations.

3. On April 9, 2026, an Initial Telephonic Hearing Notice was issued and Administrative Law Judge Alphonso Arnold (“ALJ Arnold”) issued a Prehearing Order setting an initial telephonic hearing date of May 22, 2026.

4. The Company's primary witness is unavailable to testify on May 22, 2026, due to previously scheduled time out of the office.

5. On May 6, 2026, the Company contacted the Complainant to see if he would be agreeable to a continuance of the hearing. Complainant confirmed that he is agreeable to a continuance in this matter.

6. As such, the Company respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for May 22, 2026, in this matter be continued to a later date due to the unavailability of the Company's primary witness.

II. MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

7. The Commission's regulations permit a request for continuance of a hearing upon good cause shown. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b).


8. In this case, the Company is seeking a continuance due to the unavailability of the Company's primary witness.
