**PETITION TO INTERVENE**

Before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Sections 5.71 through 5.74, Elizabeth G. Arthur 2012 Irrevocable Trust, hereby files this Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned Application(s). In support thereof, Elizabeth G. Arthur 2012 Irrevocable Trust states as follows:

Interest in this MARL proposal is as a landowner in Fayette County to which the proposed transmission line will pass through my property.

**4. State the grounds of the proposed intervention. 52 Pa. Code § 5.73(a)(2).**

Concerns with the MARL proposal to construct and maintain the transmission line are:

- a. There are no local jobs or economic benefits for the people of Fayette County.
- b. There is no reduction in energy costs for the people of Fayette County.
- c. The overall reduction to the natural beauty to the area of Fayette County.
- d. The environmental impacts caused by altering the forest cover type and watershed characteristics.
- e. The reduction of property values to local homeowners and taxpayers.
- f. The limitations placed on the owners and future property use.

**5. State Petitioner's position on the issues in the proceeding. 52 Pa. Code § 5.73(a)(3).

These proceedings should find the proposed transmission line not to be of any benefit to the taxpayers of Pennsylvania through long term jobs or economic development. If allowed, the transmission line will create negative environmental impacts by reducing and changing forest cover type and watershed conditions which will further negatively impact water quality and wildlife habitat.


