**SECOND INTERIM ORDER  
GRANTING REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE AND  
ADDRESSING PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

The parties are directed to read this Interim Order in its entirety, as it contains important information regarding the above-captioned matter.

On May 6, 2026, I received an email from the Respondent, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, requesting a continuance of the hearing scheduled for May 13, 2026, in this matter.<sup>1</sup> In the email, PPL’s counsel Megan E. Rulli attests that one of PPL’s witnesses is not available on the hearing date. Ms. Rulli states that she contacted the Complainant, Kristine Cardaci, to explain the request and that Ms. Cardaci agreed with the continuing the hearing. Ms. Rulli also states that the Complainant indicated she did not receive the Prehearing Order that rescheduled the hearing for May 13, 2026.

By separate order issued on May 7, 2026, I granted a motion to compel the Complainant to respond to PPL discovery. Responses are due to the Respondent by May 18, 2026.

<sup>1</sup> The Complainant was not copied on the email because she has not provided an email contact and receives service in this matter by mail (only). Counsel for PPL stated that the Complainant agreed to PPL emailing me directly.

PPL's request to continue the May 13, 2026 hearing will be granted, based on Ms. Rulli's representation that her witness is not available and the Complainant does not oppose the request. The continuance furthers the interest in having an orderly and efficient hearing, and the additional time will accommodate the discovery deadline noted above.

Accordingly, by this order, the May 13, 2026 hearing will be canceled, and an evidentiary hearing will be scheduled for an available hearing date.

Establishing a new date for hearing also serves to address the concern raised about notice. Notice of the May 13, 2026 hearing was provided to Ms. Cardaci in two ways: (1) a notice issued on March 19, 2026, which canceled the March 25, 2026 hearing and rescheduled the hearing for May 13, 2026 and (2) the Fourth Prehearing Order for Telephone Hearing issued on April 23, 2026, which again provided the date and time of the hearing and how to connect. The notice and prehearing order were mailed to the Complainant at the address on her Formal Complaint form and consistent with her request to be served in this matter via First-Class Mail.

The parties are responsible for promptly updating the Commission if their contact information changes during this proceeding. 52 Pa. Code § 1.53(d). If the Complainant's mailing address has changed or she wishes to be served by email, she should immediately notify the Office of Administrative Law Judge by calling 717.787.1399.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the hearing scheduled for May 13, 2026 is cancelled.
2. That the scheduling staff of the Office of Administrative Law Judge shall reschedule this matter for a telephonic hearing and notify the parties in writing.

3. That, consistent with the above Ordering paragraphs and this Order, the parties will receive separate written notice(s) canceling the May 13, 2026 hearing and rescheduling for an available date.

4. That, if the Complainant's contact information has changed, she should immediately notify the Office of Administrative Law Judge by calling 717.787.1399.
