Dear Secretary Homsher:

**Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (“Columbia”)** submits this notification of the transfer of two residential natural gas customers to Peoples Natural Gas Company, LLC (“**Peoples**”) in accordance with the Order and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission on July 12, 1977 at CN 7703/0567<sup>1</sup> (the “**Order and Certificate**”).

In accordance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of the Order and Certificate, Columbia advises that the transfer of the customers located at 186 Sportsman Road, Darlington, PA 16115 and 129 Cordak Drive, Darlington, PA 16115, is due to “**elimination of duplication of facilities.**” The transfer to **Peoples** is expected to occur by December 2026.

Columbia notified the customers of the proposal to transfer their natural gas service to **Peoples’ facilities on April 16, 2026. The customers** do not object to the transfer.
